This winner of the 2003 Pulitzer Prize for Drama is set in Tampa, Florida in 1929. The eight characters are all Cuban or Cuban-American. The following is a list, of the Spanish names and terms spoken by the characters during the action of the play.

Paul Meier, IDEA's founder and director, recorded the sound file, voiced by Natacha Seijas, a Miami/Dade County commissioner, and an ex-patriot Cuban. She is also indexed in the archive as Cuba 3.
